RE: Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between San Miguel County, CO and the Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB)

Background

The Fluvial Hazard Mapping Program (Program) was created to provide more accurate representations of natural fluvial hazard risks around the State. Phase II of this Program will develop and implement a procedure for mapping fluvial hazard areas. The CWCB will prepare technical standards, conduct studies for communities requesting mapping, and provide regulatory guidance.

Program Goals

CWCB has contracted with Amec Foster Wheeler (Amec), a nationally recognized engineering firm, to conduct the technical work for these efforts in your community and surrounding areas. In the long-term, CWCB intends to reduce damage from future flood events by increasing awareness of fluvial hazards, implement fluvial hazard mapping throughout the State of Colorado, and develop a scientifically defensible set of standards for the Rocky Mountain West.

Data

Data is being provided to participating communities for their local use and information. It may be used to plan, prepare and educate local citizens of fluvial hazard risk. The following materials will be provided:

- Fluvial Hazard Zone Maps (PDF and GIS files)
- Supporting Data (e.g., historic aerial imagery, geologic maps, etc.; PDF and GIS files)
- Fluvial Hazard Zone Guidelines and Methods Report

This project MOU represents a good-faith effort by all parties to share data and communicate necessary information and requests. The CWCB will make great effort to keep the community informed if this happens.
