Summary of Water Court Application

This is an Application for change of water right for alternate places of storage for a senior water right.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in February 2018 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

CWCB Instream Flow Water Rights

Potential for Injury

- Applicant's proposed South Fork Reservoir No.2 may inundate a portion of the CWCB's instream flow water right on lower Yellow Creek.
- The proposed change of water right could cause an expansion of use and could alter the contemplated draft of the conditional water right, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.

Statements of Opposition were also filed by 4M Ranch LLC, Exxon Mobile Corporation, Mountain Water LLC, Rio Blanco Water Conservancy District, The Oil Shale Corporation, and the United States of America - Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management, White River Field Office.
