On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I hereby request the water officials of the State of Colorado to administer in the priority system the Board's instream flow water rights on the following segments of the Elk River, Water District 58, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree.

The ELK RIVER NEAR MILNER gage is in the reach and has been used to determine that flow conditions are below the minimum for the decreed water rights. The Board is hereby placing a written call for said instream flow water rights to ensure that the full decreed amount of these water rights are made available for the decreed beneficial use of preserving the natural environment to a reasonable degree. The effective date of this call is August 8, 2018 and the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
