**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE HEARING, PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE AND

The Colorado Water Conservation Board ("CWCB"), by and through undersigned counsel, hereby moves to vacate the Hearing, the Prehearing Conference and all prehearing deadlines in this matter. As grounds for this motion, the CWCB states as follows:

1. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for Buckhorn Valley Metropolitan District No. 1 (Buckhorn) and Trout Unlimited (TU) and both parties consent to this motion.
2. The CWCB and all parties with Contested Hearing Participant Status, Buckhorn and TU, have reached a settlement regarding all issues regarding this matter.
3. Attached as Exhibit A, hereto is a Stipulation signed by the parties.
4. The deadline for submission of prehearing statements is September 11, 2018.
5. The prehearing conference is scheduled for September 12, 2018.
6. The hearing of this contested proposed instream flow appropriation is scheduled to be held in conjunction with the CWCB's meeting on November 14 and 15, 2018. Buckhorn no longer wishes to contest the Abrams Creek appropriation and TU had filed in support of the appropriation.

WHEREFORE, the CWCB requests the Hearing Officer to Vacate the Hearing, Prehearing Conference and all prehearing deadlines.
