CWCB Webinar: Colorado River Drought Contingency Planning Implementation

Join Colorado River Commissioner James Eklund and CWCB staff on Tuesday, October 9th for a webinar entitled “Colorado River Drought Contingency Planning Implementation.”

This webinar will discuss the recent challenging hydrology on the Colorado River, and the efforts of the seven Colorado River Basin States and the federal government to address the declining levels in Lakes Powell and Mead.

Commissioner Eklund and staff from the CWCB and Attorney General’s Office will review the process and draft implementation documents for the Upper and Lower Basin Drought Contingency Plans (DCPs). Panelists will discuss the opportunities the implementing documents provide, as well as the elements which will require more close work with Colorado stakeholders, such as the feasibility of demand management in the Upper Basin.

CWCB and AGO staff have been speaking at public events and policy forums for the past year, describing the DCPs and their potential elements as those evolved. Now, join us to discuss the timeline moving forward, and the draft documents that would implement these new measures to protect levels at Lakes Powell and Mead, and provide greater certainty for Colorado water users.
