The King Consolidated Ditch Company has completed the gauging station project. Our ditch rider and a couple of the directors installed the pipe structures in concrete at the midway point of the ditch and the end of the ditch where the last two laterals split. The ditch company purchased two gaging stations with solar power. After consulting with the manufacturer and reevaluating the type of structure needed to support the units, the Board decided to concrete in pipe structures that will support the solar power unit and also hang the gaging unit above the middle of the ditch for an accurate reading. This was quite a bit more cost effective and didn't require pouring concrete stilling wells and sheltering them. The ditch company's Board and ditch rider did all the work pertaining to the installation. Their personal equipment was used with exception of an auger to drill the holes.

Attached are some pictures, invoices, and a spreadsheet detailing the cost.

The CWCB was calculated to be approximately 70.75% of the funding source. The King Consolidated Ditch Company contributed the rest through our funds or in kind time and materials. Since we came in significantly under budget, it looks like the King Consolidated Ditch Company will need to return funds in the amount of \$567.45. Please advise the Ditch Company on how we need to return this amount?
