COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average





















































































SAN MIGUEL, DOLORES, ANIMAS AND SAN JUAN RIVER BASINS Reservoir Storage Departure from Average












































UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average










ARKANSAS RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average





Snowpack

- Statewide snowpack now @ 102% norm up from 95% on Wed 1/16.
- Ark strongest snowpack in state w/ 120% norm
- SMDASJ has had the best month & half since Dec 1 followed by Gunn
- U Rio G. has had a better than avg Jan but could use some more snow compared to totals back in Nov

•Precipitation Statewide

- December totals poor @ 65% norm
- GREAT start to Jan @ 124% norm
- Year to date precipitation at 101% norm
- January storms were just what CO needed, hope this continues
- •Statewide reservoir storage gained 1% since last month to now 81% of normal
