Anna:

The crop report that Mr. Harding forwarded to you was for the farm that I lease from Two Rivers known as Butte Valley Farm. During 2018 the only water utilized on Butte Valley Farm for the crops I listed was Butte Valley Ditch as presented in your Table 2; Orlando – Bradford Water Rights.

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Orlando No. 2 Reservoir had approximately 1200 A.F. diverted into it by me, but no water was released or put to beneficial use. Because of the spring and early summer drought, I appealed to the Division 2 Engineer to allow me to use that water on Butte Valley Farm. The request was denied and therefore no water was used.

None of the other water rights listed were utilized. Please be aware that prior to July 17, 2018 the Huerfano River flow dropped so low that the only direct flow water right that was diverting was the No. 1 right for Butte Valley which has 1.2 cfs decreed. Most of the first half of July I was diverting less than 1.0 cfs. When it began raining on July 17, 2018 we were hit by torrential rains and flash floods. During that time, about 200 AF was added to Orlando No. 2 Reservoir from native flows and Chitwood Arroyo, but again, no water was released or put to beneficial use from the reservoir.

Hopefully this information answers your question, but if you need something more, please call or email. I plan to attend the Arkansas River Basin Water Forum, April 24-25, 2019 at the Pueblo Convention Center; if your able to attend we can visit there.
