Summary of Water Court Application

This is an Application for absolute surface water right.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in February 2019 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.



Legal description of the point of diversion: The headgate is located in SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 85, West of the 6th P.M., Routt County, Colorado, 2420 feet from the North and 980 feet from the West lines of Section 34. Measurement obtained from CDSS map viewer. A map showing the point of diversion is attached as **EXHIBIT A.** The street address is 58740 County Road 129, Clark, CO 80428. Additional Description: NAD 83, UTM Zone 13, Easting 338546, Northing 4516509. Location provided by Water Commissioner from field inspection. 4. Source: Beaver Creek, tributary to Willow Creek, the Elk River and Yampa River. 5. A. Date of appropriation: June 13, 1923. B. How appropriation was initiated: Commencement of survey, filing map and statement with the State Engineer, and construction of the ditch. C. Date water applied to beneficial use: July 19, 1923. 6. Amount claimed: 4.0 cfs, ABSOLUTE. 7. Use: The water right has been used historically to irrigate approximately 30 acres of land owned by the Applicant in portions of the West ½ SW ¼ of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 85 West and NW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 3, Township 9 North, Range 85 West, 6th P.M. as shown on attached EXHIBIT A. Applicant intends to continue irrigating the same acreage with this water right. The land is not irrigated by any other source. 8. Owner of Land upon which all structures are Located: Applicant. 9. Remarks: The Minniear Ditch water right dates back to 1923 when the ditch was constructed by George Minniear. The water right has been used for irrigation of the same property since construction of the ditch, and the ditch and headgate are in the original locations. The Applicant has been unable to locate a decree confirming the priority of this appropriation. Evidence of the original appropriation and continued use of the ditch includes the Map and Statement accepted by the State Engineer on July 19, 1923, a copy of which is attached as **EXHIBIT B**; the depiction of the ditch on the plat of the Independent Resurvey of Township 10 North, Range 85 West approved by the Department of Interior, General Land Office on October 20, 1931, a portion of which is attached as EXHIBIT C; description of the Minniear Ditch water right in deeds to the property from George Minniear to Jim Vesely on August 6, 1930, and from Jim Vesely to Frank Vesely on May 9, 1955. Copies of those deeds are attached as **EXHIBIT D** and **EXHIBIT E.** Applicant claims the Minniear Ditch water right as a present use of water that pre-existed the appropriation of all CWCB instream flow water rights on Beaver Creek, Willow Creek, the Elk River, and Yampa River, if any. All instream flow water rights were decreed subject to this use, as described in Section 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S. WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the court to confirm an absolute water right for the Minniear Ditch as described in this application.
