The Basin Roundtables were instrumental in development of the recently adopted Colorado Water Plan and will play a key role in the Plan's implementation.

The general public and other interested "stakeholders" are invited and encouraged to attend Roundtable meetings and actively participate in the Colorado Basin Roundtable process.
