
COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average

























































































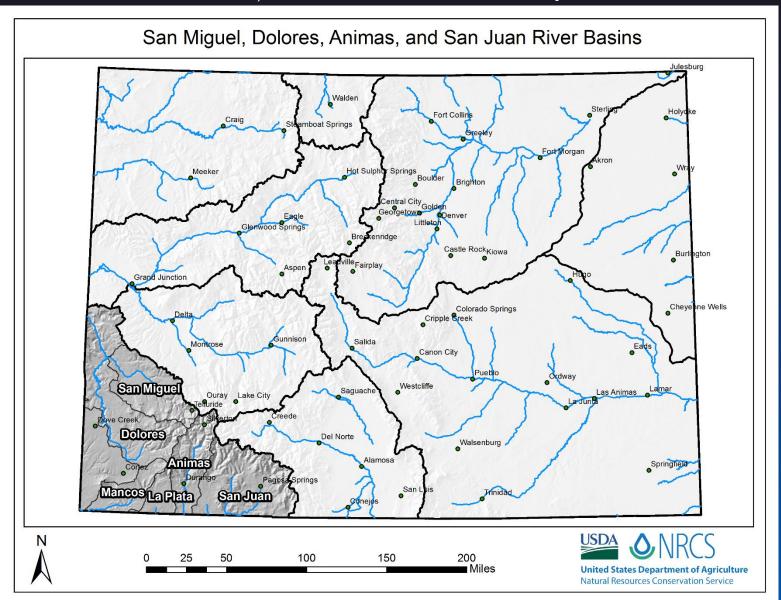


GUNNISON RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average














































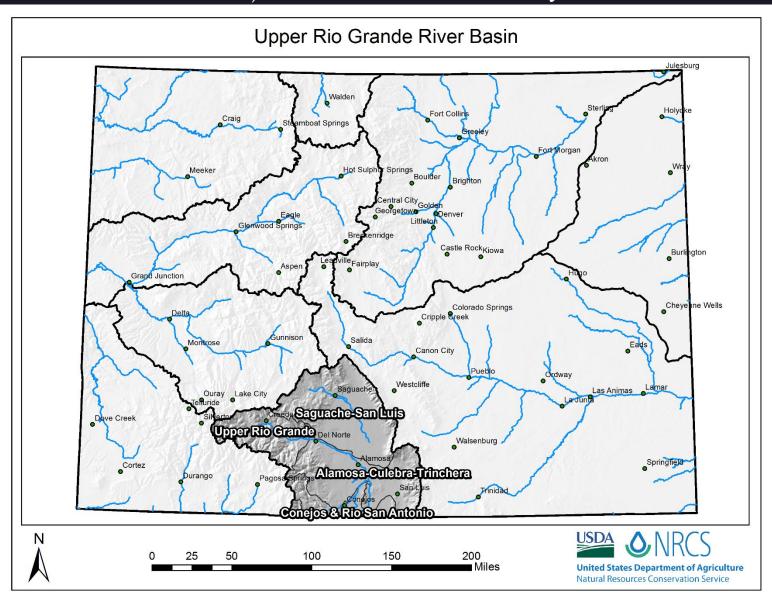
SAN MIGUEL, DOLORES, ANIMAS AND SAN JUAN RIVER BASINS Reservoir Storage Departure from Average


















































UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average





ARKANSAS RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average








Summary

Precipitation Statewide

- March precipitation ended up at 183% of average statewide
- April has been considerable more dry but all major basins still have well above average water year precipitation

Snowpack

- Statewide snowpack now @ 125% median
- SMDASJ best snowpack in state w/ 160% median
- Snowmelt has been occurring at all but a few high elevation SNOTEL sites in the state
- Snowpack is not currently the best in the period of record but is one of the best in most southern basins
- •Statewide reservoir storage 84% of normal- minimal change
- April 1 streamflow forecasts were boosted substantially across southern Colorado and are for above average volumes statewide
