Introduction

For fiscal year 2018-2019, the storage and supply category was appropriated \$3 million in funding. After the first round of grant funding, the unreserved balance in the storage and supply category is \$2,650,000. In the second round of fiscal year 2018-2019 applications, the CWCB received six applications ⁽¹⁾ for the storage and supply category totaling \$3,075,670. Staff is recommending approval of the four grants totaling \$1,649,786 leaving \$1,000,214 available for future rounds of grant funding. Staff is recommending delaying the decision on one grant request totaling \$1,000,000. If that grant is approved at a future meeting, \$214 will remain available for future rounds of grant funding.
