






















































































COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average








































































































SAN MIGUEL, DOLORES, ANIMAS AND SAN JUAN RIVER BASINS Reservoir Storage Departure from Average
















































UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average








ARKANSAS RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average















COLORADO STATEWIDE Reservoir Storage Departure from Average







Summary

Precipitation Statewide

- May precipitation was above normal for the month.
- June so far has seen 150% of normal precipitation
- Year to date precipitation is currently 124% of normal

Snowpack

- Statewide remains at about 15% of SNOTELs across the state
- Has persisted this late before, such as in 2011 (very close to this year) and in 1995
- 12% of this year's snowpack remains to melt according to SNOTEL
- 2019 Peak snowpack ranked 6th at 130% median among 34 yrs in the POR
 - Similar to 2011, 1986, 2008, highest was 1993 at 151% median.
- •Statewide reservoir storage is 90 percent of average
- •Above average May streamflows occurred across most of the state
- •Minimal forecasts produced in June
