COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average








































































GUNNISON RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average



































SAN MIGUEL, DOLORES, ANIMAS AND SAN JUAN RIVER BASINS Reservoir Storage Departure from Average


































UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average





ARKANSAS RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average


















































Summary

- Precipitation Statewide
 - June ended with above average precipitation but July has been very dry across the state
 - Many SNOTEL sites and areas have received little to no precipitation
- •Statewide reservoir storage has grew considerably through June with well above average streamflows
 - Great recovery across the Western and Southwest basins after storage was very depleted last year
- •With a late and large snowpack runoff there is the possibility June-July total streamflow volumes will be some of the largest observed on record in many areas
