NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF PARTY STATUS

Western Resource Advocates, by and through the undersigned counsel, submits the following Notice of Withdrawal of Party Status regarding the CWCB Staff ISF Recommendations on Disappointment Creek, Water Division No. 7. As grounds therefor, Western Resource Advocates states the following:

- 1. Based upon the original recommendations of the United States Bureau of Land Management, Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) Staff urged the CWCB Board to declare its intent to appropriate the above-captioned instream flow water rights for Disappointment Creek ("Disappointment Creek ISFs") at its January 2019 meeting.
- 2. On January 29, 2019, the CWCB Board declared its intent to appropriate the Disappointment Creek ISFs.
- 3. On March 28, 2019, Dolores County filed a timely notice to contest the Disappointment Creek ISFs under to Rule 5k of the Rules Concerning the Colorado Instream Flow and Natural Lake Level Program, 2 CCR 408-2 ("ISF Rules").
- 4. On April 30, 2019, Western Resource Advocates filed a timely Notice of Party Status in the contested ISF Appropriations under ISF Rule 5*l*. No other persons or entities filed for party status.
- 5. On April 30, 2019, the Southwestern Water Conservation District filed a timely Notice of Hearing Participant Status under ISF Rule 5m.
- 6. During its May 2019 meeting, the CWCB Board agreed to consider both proposed Disappointment Creek ISFs in one joint proceeding.

- 7. On September 5, 2019, Dolores County submitted a Notice of Withdrawal of Notice to Contest Instream Flow Appropriations in the above-captioned matter, attached hereto as Western Resource Advocates' Exhibit A.
- 8. On September 6, 2019, counsel for CWCB Staff filed an Unopposed Motion to Vacate Hearing, Prehearing Conference and Prehearing Deadlines. Because the pending unopposed motion and Dolores County's withdrawal resolve all disputes in this matter, Western Resource Advocates submits this Notice of Withdrawal of Party Status.

Wherefore, Western Resource Advocates hereby submits this Notice of Withdrawal of Party Status in the contested Disappointment Creek ISF Appropriations.
