# ORDER GRANTING CWCB STAFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE HEARING ON NOVEMBER 20-21, 2019

THIS MATTER comes before the Hearing Officer on CWCB Staff's unopposed motion to vacate the hearing in this matter currently scheduled during CWCB's November 20-21, 2019 meeting in the Denver metro area. The Hearing Officer, having reviewed the motion and being otherwise adequately advised, GRANTS the motion.

CWCB Staff and the only party contesting the proposed instream flow appropriation, S&T Farms LLC, entered into a stipulation on September 5, 2019. That stipulation was approved by the CWCB board at its September 18, 2019 meeting. S&T Farms subsequently withdrew its notice to contest the proposed instream flow appropriation. Thus, no parties remain who contest the instream flow appropriation, and therefore no hearing is necessary in this matter.

The hearing in this matter set for November 20-21, 2019 is hereby VACATED. This matter is returned to the Colorado Water Conservation Board for further administrative action.
