



















































































COLORADO RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average



































































































GUNNISON RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average






























































UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average

















































































Summary

- •Precipitation Statewide
 - July, August, and September have all had well below average mountain precipitation across all major basins in Colorado
 - Near or below 50 percent of normal values for all three months
 - Water year to date precipitation ranges from 107 to 120 percent of average
- •Reservoir storage remains above average in all major basins
 - Storage ranges from 111-132 percent of average in the basins as is 116 percent of average statewide
 - Overall very similar to last month
- •While the last several months have been dry having ample reservoir storage is encouraging as winter approaches
- •A dusting of snow occurred at Tower SNOTEL last week but no other accumulations have been observed at a SNOTEL site so far
