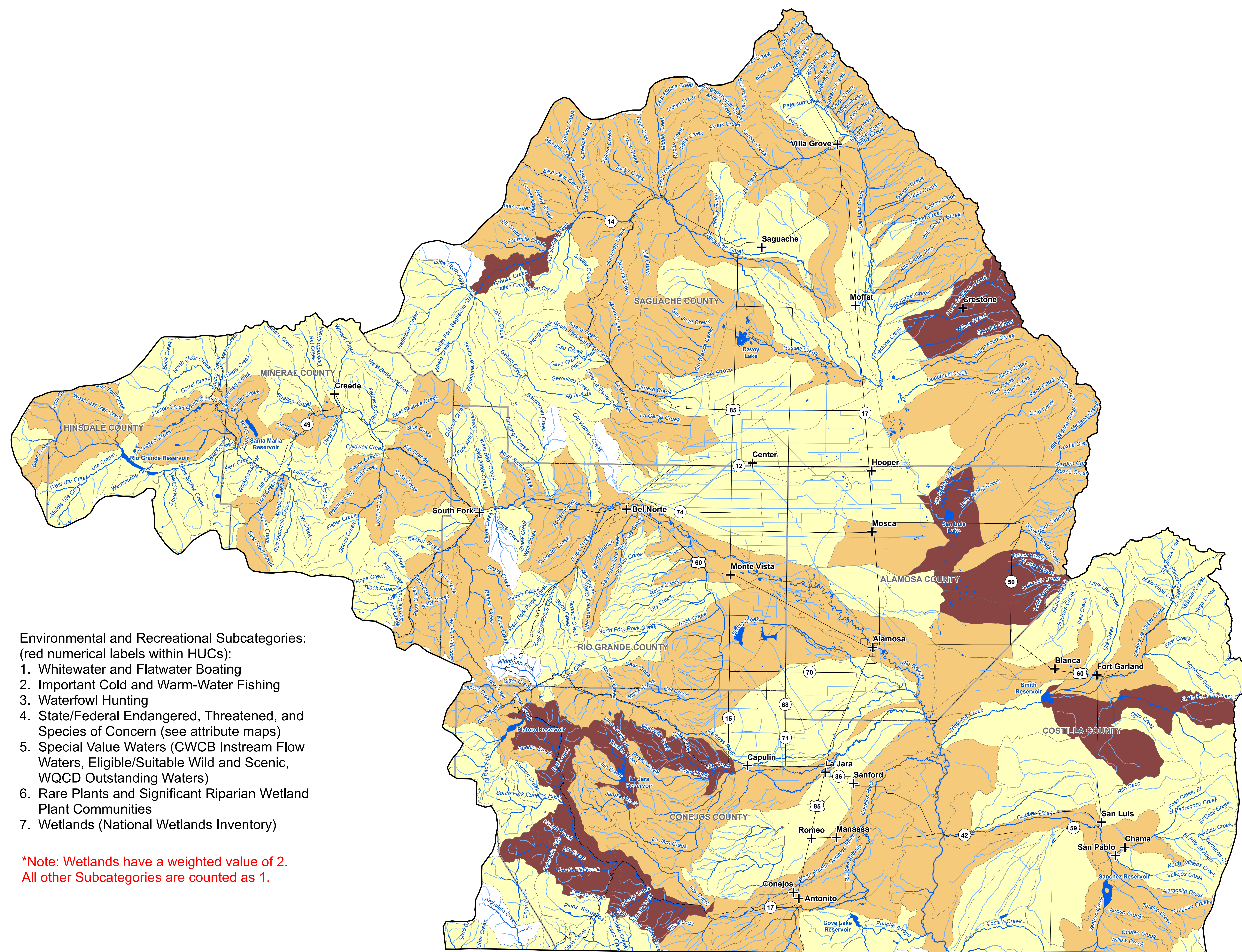


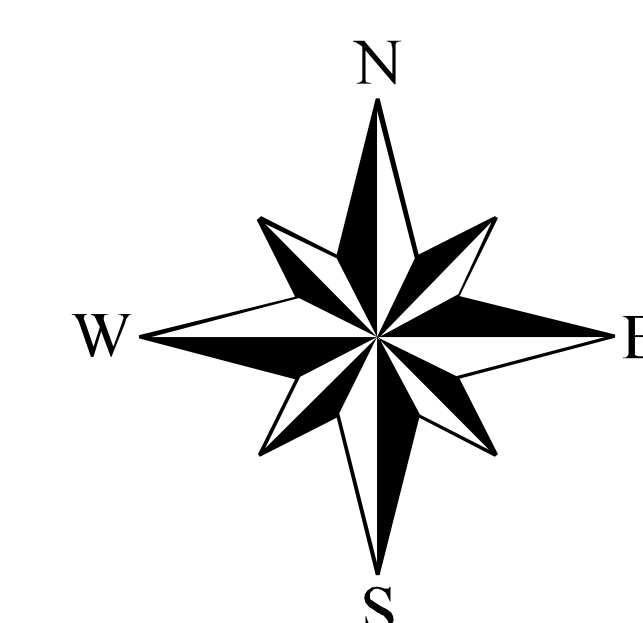


Environmental and Recreational Subcategories:
(red numerical labels within HUCs):

1. Whitewater and Flatwater Boating
2. Important Cold and Warm-Water Fishing
3. Waterfowl Hunting
4. State/Federal Endangered, Threatened, and Species of Concern (see attribute maps)
5. Special Value Waters (CWCB Instream Flow Waters, Eligible/Suitable Wild and Scenic, WQCD Outstanding Waters)
6. Rare Plants and Significant Riparian Wetland Plant Communities
7. Wetlands (National Wetlands Inventory)

***Note: Wetlands have a weighted value of 2.
All other Subcategories are counted as 1.**
