## Summary of Water Court Application

## **Staff Recommendation**

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in February 2020 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

## Potential for Injury


- The proposed appropriative right of exchange should be defined clearly with a reference to intervening instream flow water rights so that the CWCB's instream flow water rights are not injured.
- Augmentation use is claimed for Rainbow Reservoir. The augmentation use should be tied to the companion case filed by Applicant in Case No. 19CW3102.
