The Big Grizzly Phase 2 - Construction is 100% complete.

Task 1: Construction-\$50,105 - Complete Task 2: Administration-\$5,053 - Complete

The project included both the installation of a new diversion on the Big Grizzly Creek and a new headgate on the Big Grizzly ditch. Both structures are concrete with aluminum screw gates adhered to provide water control. The diversion structure has three 8-foot aluminum screw gates, whereas, the headgate structure has just one 6-foot gate. Sessions and Sons constructed and installed both structures. A large amount of rock rip rap was also used to armor the banks both upstream and downstream of each structure, as well as the location where the old check/diversion structure was removed.

This project was a very complex project that took a lot of time and effort to install. The contractor ran out of time late, late last fall due to ice buildup and therefore, had to go back and complete the project this spring. Erodible soils and a large amount of water in the Big Grizzly creek also made installation more difficult. No major problems were encountered. The proposed budget is identical to the actual invoice.

The Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) certified the structures and they were constructed and installed as per their Standards and Specifications for Structures for Water Control. NRCS approved the matching payment amount of \$40,679.20 to cover POGG1 2020-2584. The landowner contributed \$10,169.80.

Therefore, we are requesting final payment from CWCB's WSRF for POGG1 2020-2584: \$55,158.00: \$50,105 to cover Phase 2-Construction and \$5,053 for Owl Mountain Partnership's 8% administration fee.
