Their work will be limited to developing recommendations on projects and other aspects of the BIP update which will then be presented to the full roundtable for consideration and potential adoption.

One subcommittee of 6 to 8 people will focus on agriculture and municipal/industrial. ***If there are voting members of the roundtable willing to serve on this subcommittee, please contact Ty as soon as possible.***

That committee will have its **first meeting next Tue, June 9 from 7-9pm** at the Wattenberg Center, which will provide sufficient space for the recommended physical distancing. Please plan to wear a face mask, part of the COVID-19 recommendations.

Physical attendance at the meeting will be limited to the subcommittee membership. In addition, the meeting will be open to the public to listen by phone.
