JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Hearing Officer's June 17, 2020, Order, the Staff of the Colorado Water Conservation Board ("CWCB Staff"), Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"), Knott Land and Livestock Company, Inc., and Twentymile Coal, LLC (collectively, "Parties"), hereby submit the following joint status report:

In October 2019, the Parties agreed to continue the hearing scheduled in this matter so CWCB Staff and the BLM could take additional stream measurements on Trout Creek this summer. Consistent with that plan, the Parties have scheduled the additional stream measurements to take place on July 9-10, and August 24-25, and recently met via videoconference on June 23 to discuss the details for the July stream measurements and the process for selecting the stream measurement sites. The number of individuals who will attend the stream measurements will be limited, and the Parties believe they can maintain appropriate social distancing practices.

Thus, the plan is to move forward consistent with the October 22, 2019, Order Granting Revised Joint Motion Requesting Continuance of Hearing to November 2020, and the deadlines stated therein. At this time, the Parties do not desire a status conference to be scheduled in this matter until the prehearing status conference currently scheduled for October 7, 2020.
