On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I am requesting administration of the Board's instream flow water rights on the following segments of the Eagle River, in Water District 37, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree. Additional information about the specific ISF reaches is shown below.

The EAGLE RIVER BELOW MILK CREEK NEAR WOLCOTT, CO and the EAGLE R BLW WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT AVON, CO gages are located in the ISF reaches and demonstrates that flow conditions are below the decreed ISF water rights. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water rights is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is August 24, 2020 and the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
