Dear CWCB:

The "VanValkenburg Staples 1 Ditch" project has been completed. This project replaced two, old, dilapidated turnout structures that currently exist in the Staples 1 Ditch with one, functional check structure that includes two built-in turnouts. The structure will allow the water users to control water not only in the ditch but at the two turnout locations as well. RLW Enterprises performed the installation.

No major obstacles were encountered with the installation of the project.

The proposed budget is identical to the actual budget.

The NRCS certified the structure for water control. The structure meets NRCS's Standards and Specifications for Structure for Water Control #587. NRCS approved the matching payment amount of \$18,360.00. The landowner contributed \$4,164.00.

Therefore, we are requesting a final payment of \$40,474.00: \$37,476 from CWCB's WSRF to cover the remaining cost of installation and \$2,998.00 for Owl Mountain Partnership's 8% administration fee.
