

National Trends

- # of fires decreasing, # of acres increasing
- 2020 58,950 fires (below 5yr and 10yr avg)
- 2020 10,122,335 acres (2015 & 2017 > 10M)
- 17,904 structures destroyed (10yr avg 4,911)




Colorado Big Fires


- 4 of the 20 largest fires occurred in 2020 (#1-3)
- 9 of top 20 (45%) have occurred since 2018
- 15 of top 20 those (75%) have occurred since
 2012
- All 20 (100%) have occurred since 2001






