On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I am requesting administration of the Board's instream flow water right on the following segment of the Colorado River, in Water District 51, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree. The COLORADO RIVER AT WINDY GAP, NEAR GRANBY, CO and COLORADO RIVER AT HOT SULPHUR SPRINGS, CO gages are located in the ISF reach and demonstrate that flow conditions are below the decreed rate for the ISF water right. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water right is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is October 25, 2022.
