Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m. by Chairperson Steve Anderson.

Roll Call/Introductions

After roll call a quorum was declared to be present.

Agenda Approval

Members asked to add a letter of support for City of Grand Junction and change the Agenda Approval of Minutes to read 2022, not 2021.

Bill Nesbitt moved to approve the Agenda as corrected. Allen Distel seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes from the July 18, 2022 Meeting

Wendell Koontz stated he was at the July meeting.

Allen Distel moved to approve the minutes of the July 18, 2022 meeting as corrected. Bill Nesbitt seconded and the motion passed. Sonja Chavez and Jonathan Houck were absent at the meeting and abstained.

Election to fill at large seat

John McClow stated only statutory members can vote for At-Large seats. It will require a 2/3rds vote of regular members and should be a secret vote.

There was discussion as to whether Roundtable members can vote online, by text or by email and whether candidates must be present and if they could be present via zoom. Members requested information on candidates and to put the election off to the next meeting in order to have time to review the candidates.

Alan Distel moved to table the election to the next meeting in November. Joanne Fagan seconded.

There was more discussion as to whether the candidates needed to show up in person or could attend via zoom. John McClow stated the bylaws were changed and provide that members of the roundtable can participate and vote by audio and video conference, and felt it was only fair the candidates should be able to do this also. Steve Anderson stated a resume and letter of interest for each candidate will be sent to everyone in advance, and the candidates will be required to attend in person or via zoom.

The motion carried unanimously.

Education Committee Report (Sonja Chavez)

Sonja Chavez and Cindy McKee gave an update on the activities of the Education Committee. They have applied for the State PEPO Grant for \$25,000 but have not yet received the funds. As soon as funds are released, they will begin distributing the funds for administrative communication work, student education and public education.

WSRF Guidelines (Jeff Rodriguez)

Jeff Rodriguez discussed WSRF funding and guidelines. They are in the process of hiring regional coordinators who will be administering water plan grants, assisting roundtables, and performing other outreach duties.

There will be an increase in recorder funds and they have purchased audio visual equipment for each basin. The Chair of the Roundtable will designate someone to be in charge of the equipment.

The Water Plan comment period ends September 30. The last listening session, dedicated to agriculture, will be on September 28.

There is a significant amount of funding available. They are proposing each Roundtable receive \$1M and are reserving 3 years of WSRF funding to protect from variability in severance tax revenues. They will be bringing back state-wide matching and increasing PEPO funding. The next CWCB board meeting starts tomorrow.

Grant Review Committee Report (Tom Alvey)

Tom Alvey stated there were no requests for this meeting, but he expects a couple grant applications coming in for the November meeting. After new funding levels are known there will be more requests coming in quickly.

Colorado Water Conservation Board Report (Steve Anderson)

Steve Anderson reported and briefly discussed WSRF funding. He said the constant debate at the CWCB Board meeting is the Colorado River. August 15 came and went and no one came up with any water for the downstream reservoirs. Steve says he finds it hard to believe that our water is at much risk from the federal government legally coming in and taking water from us. The Lower Basin needs to live within their means. The next meeting is in Durango starting tomorrow.

Interbasin Compact Committee Report (Joann Fagan, Mark Roeber)

Joanne Fagan had no report. The next meeting will be October 25, 2022.

Other Business

Randy Kim from the City of Grand Junction gave a presentation for their request for a letter of support for a conservation and land use planning grant. The grant request is for a graywater system which will save around 20% of their water.

Joanne Fagan moved the Gunnison Basin Roundtable provide a letter of support for the City of Grand Junction's conservation and land use planning grant. Bill Nesbitt seconded and the motion passed.

Randy Kim will send a draft letter to Steve Anderson.
