1. Welcome/Introductions (Sean Chambers - 5 min.)

- 5. WSRF (Garrett Varra 5 min.)
 - 1. WSRF Update and SPBRT Funds Status <u>CWCB Basin Account Funds</u>
 There is \$511,000 in the SPBRT WSRF account. The new WSRF guidelines include a pre-application period in March. Seven applications were received. Full applications are due by Friday. A review of applications was made, and questions were taken back to the applicants. There will be a recommendation letter from the WSRF Committee for each application at the May SPBRT meeting.

A presentation on lessons learned from the East Troublesome and Cameron Peaks fires specific to policy, collaboration, and technical focus was shared. Challenges and observations were discussed. The presentation is available by request.

7. Colorado Division of Water Resources Data Logger/Telemetry Installation Project Update (Brent Schantz, DWR River Operations & Compact Coordinator – 10 min.)

Progress was reported on the data logger/telemetry installation project grant. There will be 149 sites instead of the 114 due to water users purchasing their own equipment. The grant has 10 more telemetry sites remaining to install. There is a great demand from water officials and users to have real-time data. They are 98% complete. The goal is to finish the grant deliverables by June 30, 2023.

- 4. Colorado River/Demand Management (Sean Chambers & Kyle Whitaker 10 min.) A presentation was provided. Discussed comparison of SEIS alternatives. Thirty-six System Conservation Pilot Program proposals were received. No action has been taken on the proposals.

 - 1. Colorado Water Congress State Affairs Committee 2023 Tracking Sheet
 - 2. Stream Restoration Legislation (DNR Policy Staff) <u>Stream Restoration [Unedited Draft 3-28]</u> Kelly Romero-Heaney provided a presentation and a link to <u>Colorado River Commissioner's Corner | Colorado Department of Natural Resources (engagecwcb.org)</u>. Discussed values of healthy natural stream systems and reviewed impacts to Colorado streams. Focused on water rights and stream restoration and the terms Diversion, Storage, and Unnecessary Obstruction. DNR is working to provide clarity in statute section 37-92-602, C.R.S. The stream restoration legislation would add a new subsection (9) describing the benefits and requirements for stream restoration projects. They are working toward a suitable cap on these types of projects.
