1. PEPO Committee (Casey Davenport - 5 min.) (*No Meeting*) The 2023 grant application was submitted. A number of events are coming up including the SP CURE annual October event, Sustaining Colorado Watersheds Conference in October, Cherry Creek Stewardship Partners Conference in August, and the Children's Watershed Festival in Sterling. PEPO is participating in the North Front Range Water Quality Planning Association (NFRWQPA) meetings to identify stakeholder processes already in place. NFRWQPA is working on developing an EPA 9-point watershed plan.

4. Colorado River/Demand Management (Sean Chambers & Kyle Whitaker – 10 min.) An update was provided on the status of the Lake Meade/Lake Powell EIS. There are not a lot of details on the Lower Basin plan. The seven states continue to meet. Discussed lake levels and reductions. The

State has formed a Colorado River Drought Task Force as directed by SB23-295 and it is expected that task force meetings will be scheduled. It was noted that the bill creating the task force was controversial in some stakeholder communities, it has been created to develop recommendations for state legislation that provides additional tools for the CWCB Board.


