Staff Recommendation

Potential for Injury

- Applicant claims some water rights with appropriation dates prior to the appropriation of CWCB's instream flow water rights. The CWCB's instream flow water rights may be subject to the beneficial uses in existence on the date of such instream flow appropriation under section 37-92-102(3)(b), C.R.S., so long as the uses are sufficiently demonstrated and documented.
- For any decree entered in this case, terms and conditions should be included to ensure that the proposed decree will not injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
