Summary of Water Court Application

Application for Conditional Storage Rights and Change of Water Rights to Add Places of Storage.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in February 2024 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

CWCB Instream Flow Water Rights

The CWCB holds water rights, including the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 1 in the St. Vrain Creek Watershed, that could be injured by this application:

Potential for Injury

- The claimed change of storage locations for the water rights could injure the intervening instream flow water rights.
- The claimed change of water rights could result in an expansion of use, which could injure instream flow water rights.
- Any reuse and successive use of the water requires a detailed reuse plan so that other water rights are not injured.
- Terms and conditions should be included in any decree entered in the case to ensure that the proposed claims will not injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.

Statements of Opposition were also filed by: Water Users Association of District No. 6 (the "WUA"); Town of Nederland; Gary Wockner, Mark Easter, and Save The World's Rivers; City of Boulder ("Boulder"); and Public Service Company of Colorado, a Colorado corporation ("PSCo").
