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The Water and Equity Partnership will work with CWCB on the Colorado Water Plan update process to promote equity, inclusion, environmental justice, and visibility for historically underserved communities; a starting point and vehicle for broad, lasting engagement from BIPOC communities in the water planning process.

Education and access to resources and influence are paramount for this work. The project partners will create and disseminate materials regarding water power structures, western water law, current events and issues, water policy, and more. The project will engage young and BIPOC producers in educational sessions and further enrichment opportunities to increase widespread education and advocacy, and also to build community and collective power for a broader water and equity community. After engaging with a broad group of producers in the Water Plan public comment, the project will engage a cohort of 10 producers to participate in the water fellowship to further develop their water knowledge and leadership skills. Upon completion of the program, fellows will be equipped to continue the work of spreading water policy knowledge and advocacy skills throughout their local agricultural communities.
