1. Greetings, Introductions, Establish Quorum

• Mark called the meeting to order confirming a quorum in attendance.

 - o Terry Scanga opened the discussion on the IBCC purpose he has been checking into. Terry pointed out the role as stated in the Charter is to create a forum for Compact negotiations between Basin's. As such, this is its primary role. The Roundtable's purpose was to create and find more water supplies. Mark asked Terry what he perceived as the course drift in the perceived role. Terry responded that we've gone off track e.g. administrative overreach. There were discussions on the roles as defined for the IBCC and the Roundtables focusing on the interpretations of CRS 37-75-101 and HB05 1177 regarding water protection vs water exploration. Russ Sands discussed the input from IBCC for the Water Plan and several other issues such as the Low Regrets Action Plan. Terry pointed out the need for an effective IBCC and the changes since the initial inception of its creation.
 - Jeff Rodriguez suggested that it would be helpful if there are still questions and or concerns that we review 1177 and the IBCC Charter and look into the CWCB Guide and he and Russ would welcome any feedback from members. Several issues regarding the CWCB Guide were discussed and Mark suggested discussing this topic further during an upcoming meeting.
