The BEAR RIVER AT CR7 NEAR YAMPA, CO gage and the BEAR RIVER AT BOX K RANCH gage are in the ISF reach and demonstrate that flow conditions are below the decreed ISF water right. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water right is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is August 13, 2024 and the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
