On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I am requesting administration of the Board's instream flow ("ISF") water right on the following segment of Dallas Creek, in Water District 68, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree. Additional information about the specific ISF reach is shown below.

The DALLAS CREEK NEAR RIDGWAY, CO. gage is located in the ISF reach and demonstrates that flow conditions are below the decreed flow rate for the ISF water right. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water right is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is May 13, 2024, and if required the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
