6. Colorado River District (Andy Mueller & Zane Kessler) (45 Min.)

The Colorado River District is a government entity that advocates for its constituent that was formed in 1937 to protect West Slope water users and to safeguard for Colorado all waters of the Colorado River to which the state is entitled. The Shoshone water rights are large and senior non-consumptive right on the Colorado River – 1250 cfs under a 1902 right and 158 cfs under a 1929 right. In December 2023, the Colorado River District and Xcel Energy entered into an agreement to transfer ownership of the water rights for \$99 million. Benefits on the West Slope from the headwaters to the state line and statewide were discussed.

7. 2025 Legislative Session Overview (Nate Pearson, Assistant Director for Water Policy, DNR) (15 Min.)

DNR legislation being advanced was discussed.

Abandoned Mine SB25-054 – facilitate creation of a permit to allow reclaiming/remediation waste rock piles and remove metals from piles. Targets dry waste rock piles that contribute metals during runoff periods.

Mapping Water Supply HB25–1115 – Funding for flights, data, and analysis of snow monitoring program.

Carbon management and geothermal development HB 25 1165 - Responsible development of

geothermal. Not yet scheduled in committee.

Bill for process improvements across Division of Water Resources – Processes to expire permits, abandonment process, etc.

Part of Governor's January 2nd budget – Generate additional revenue from limiting deductions from sports betting.

8. Agricultural Stewardship Tax Credit (<u>HB24-1249</u>) (John Miller, CO Dept. of Agriculture (CDA)/Soil Health Program Manager) (15 Min.)

Legislation from the 2024 cycle. HB24-1249 regarding stewardship practices on farms based on practices implemented. First year is 2026, and the last year is 2030. Cannot overlap with existing grants or tax credits. Discussed practices that qualify for credit grouped by crop practices, annual and perennial, and supplemental practices. Applications will open in Fall 2025 and posted on the CDA website, ag.colorado.gov/ag-stewardship-tax. There will be a webinar available through the CDA portal on February 26th.
