Recommendations

Staff Recommendation: This is an informational item with no Board action required.

Background

Pursuant to Rule 5c. of the Rules Concerning the Colorado Instream Flow (ISF) and Natural Lake Level (NLL) Program ("ISF Rules"), Staff is providing notice that the following 25 stream segments have been recommended for ISF appropriation (See Table 1). At the January 2026 CWCB meeting, Staff may request that the Board form its intent to appropriate ISF water rights on recommendations where sufficient information and outreach has been completed.

The list below includes 4 new recommendations (identified with an *) and 21 recommendations received in previous years. The previous recommendations have not moved forward due to the need for additional scientific data and/or ongoing attempts to address stakeholder issues.

Outreach

Staff will complete several outreach efforts to raise awareness about these recommendations. This includes providing public notice of the recommendations in March and November of 2025 to the ISF subscription mailing list. Staff will offer to give presentations to County Commissioners in counties with ISF recommendations. Staff will mail letters to landowners adjacent to the proposed ISF reaches and inform them about the ISF Program and the recommendation. In addition, staff will publish notices in newspapers located near the recommended ISF reaches. Lastly, staff plans to contact water commissioners, water right holders, and others when possible to discuss the recommendations.
