Summary of Water Court Application

Application to Confirm Decreed Alternate Point of Diversion, for Absolute Storage Rights, and for Conditional and Absolute Groundwater Rights.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in February 2025 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

CWCB Instream Flow Water Rights

The CWCB holds water rights, including the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 5 in the Upper White River Watershed, that could be injured by this application:

Potential for Injury

- Some of the claimed water rights will have associated delayed depletions that cannot be curtailed. These depletions require an augmentation to replace depletions in the proper time, place, and amount, to prevent injury to the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- The claim that groundwater diversions result in instantaneous depletions requires further investigation.
- Terms and conditions should be included in the decree to ensure that the proposed change will not injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
