DENVER WATER’S MOTION TO SUBMIT CORRECTED VERSION OF EXHIBIT 8.a.

CONCERNING THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF AN INTEREST IN THE SHOSHONE WATER RIGHTS FOR INSTREAM FLOW USE, COLORADO RIVER WATER DIVISIONS NO. 5

The City and County of Denver, acting by and through its Board of Water Commissioners (“Denver Water”), submits this motion to request leave to substitute a corrected exhibit labeled as Denver Exhibit 8.a.1 for Denver Exhibit 8.a as originally submitted on August 4, 2025. As grounds for this motion, Denver Water states:

1. On August 4, 2025, Denver Water submitted Denver Exhibit 8.a, which consists of a table (Table 1) and two figures.
2. Following submittal of Denver Exhibit 8.a, Denver Water’s witness, Ms. Heather Thompson, observed Table 1 of Denver Exhibit 8.a had not been updated to correspond with the final version of the table. Note that a similar version of Table 1 that represents the final form of Table 1 appears in her technical memorandum submitted by Denver Water as Denver Exhibit 5.
3. Denver Water requests leave to substitute Denver Exhibit 8.a with Denver Exhibit 8.a.1 which contains the final version of Table 1, which is also the same as Table 1 set forth in Denver Exhibit 5. No party should be prejudiced by this request because all parties already have the final correct version of Table 1 in Denver Exhibit 5.
4. A copy of Exhibit 8.a.1 is attached to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Denver Water requests leave to substitute Denver Exhibit 8.a with Denver Exhibit 8.a.1, as attached to this motion.

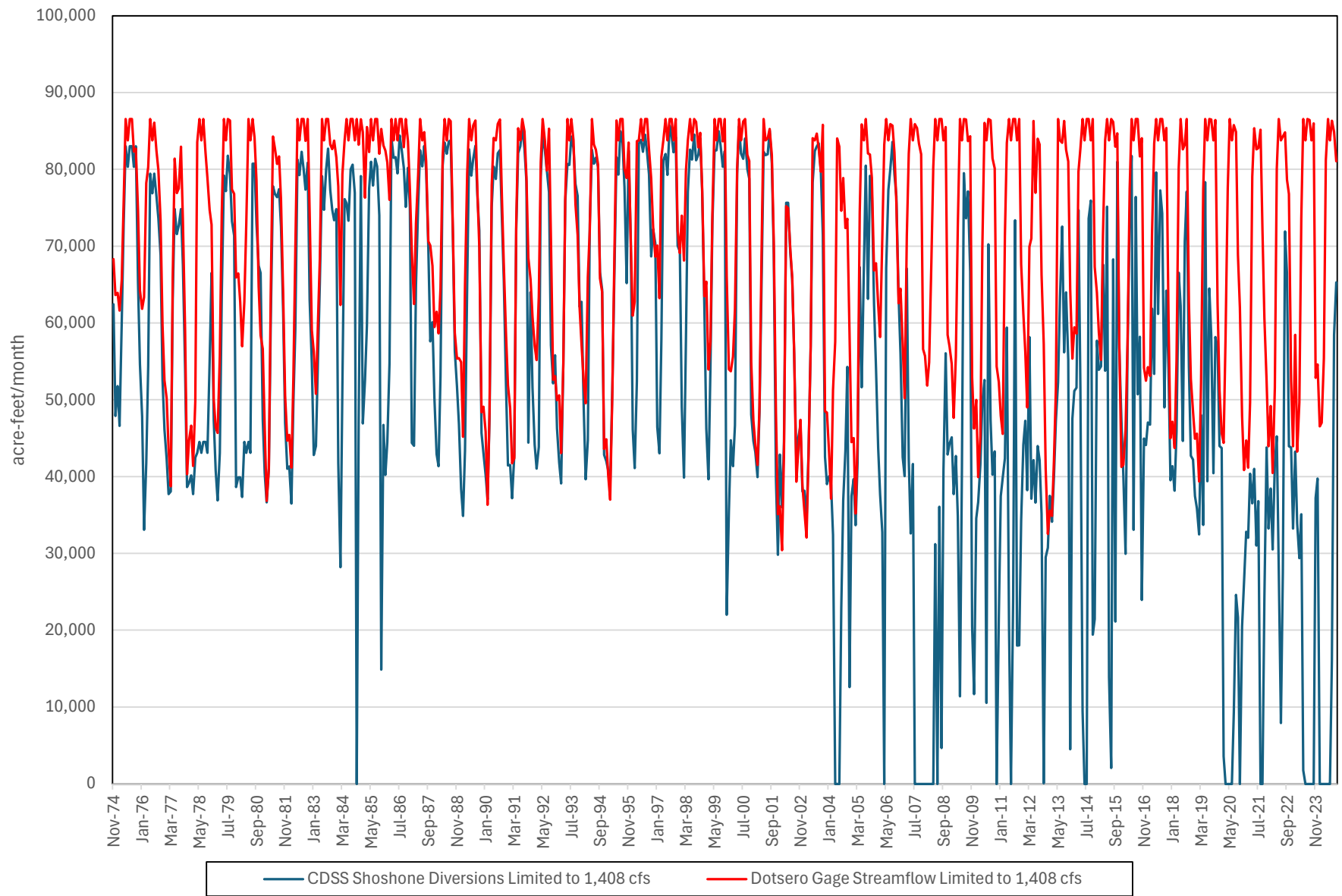


Figure 2: Comparison of Historical Use Analysis Results (ERC, 2025a)
