


Williams Creek Water Rights Purchase

Rio Grande Water Conservation District
Special Improvement District No. 2
Substantially Complete September 1, 2025



Project Description

The Rio Grande Water Conservation District, Special Improvement District No. 2, purchased a fractional share of the Williams Creek SPD Transbasin Water Right equivalent to 54.1 acre-feet. The Subdistrict will use this water right as a source of augmentation water to replace depletions caused by groundwater wells within the Subdistrict to the Rio Grande basin.

Due to its location, water delivered under the Williams Creek SPD Transbasin Water Right can be used to augment flows to all reaches of the Rio Grande below Grizzly Creek. Water delivered under this right can also be stored via exchange with nearby Rio Grande Reservoir. In addition to the 54.1 acre-feet allotment, the Williams Creek SPD also allows for diversion of additional water under free river conditions as applicable.
