Summary of Water Court Application

Application for Change of Conditional Water Storage Rights.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in September 2025 to protect CWCB's instream flow water.

CWCB Instream Flow Water Rights

The CWCB holds water rights, including the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 5 in the Colorado River Headwaters Watershed, that could be injured by this application:

Potential for Injury

- The proposed change of water rights could cause an expansion of use and could alter the time, place, and amount of return flows, which could injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
- A contemplated draft analysis that considers how the water rights would have been historically used is necessary to ensure there is no expansion of use, which could cause injury to the instream flow water rights, by the proposed change.
- Terms and conditions should be included in the decree to ensure that the proposed decree will not injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.
