	Kelsea MacIlroy, The Langdon Group, led the discussion to review the <a href="#">Conversation Guide</a> created with the NLR Subcommittee. The Conversation Guide is meant to serve as a resource for IBCC members leading NLR discussions at their basin roundtable meetings.
3	<b>Brainstorm &amp; Outline Process for gathering NLR Data from Basin Roundtables</b>
	<p>Kelsea MacIlroy, The Langdon Group, facilitated a breakout session designed to help IBCC members work together to brainstorm approaches for leading the NLR discussions at their basin roundtables. The discussions focused on creating schedules for roundtables to meet the IBCC NLR Schedule, the need for outside facilitation, presentations from experts, and CWCB support throughout the process. Kelsea helped summarize the feedback from the breakout sessions in a report. Common outcomes of the discussions were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The need to explain No &amp; Low Regrets before each discussion at the BRT</li><li>• Creating a shared folder with resources for IBCC and BRT members</li><li>• The desire for outside facilitation support</li><li>• More clarity on future discussion topics</li><li>• More clarity about what the outcome and schedule of revisiting topics will be</li><li>• The desire for subject matter expert presentations</li></ul>
