On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I am requesting administration of the Board's instream flow water rights on the following segments of Eagle River, in Water District 37, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree. Additional information about the specific ISF reaches are shown below.

The EAGLE R BLW WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT AVON, CO (WDID 3702041) and the EAGLE RIVER BELOW MILK CREEK NEAR WOLCOTT, CO (WDID 3702059) gages indicate flow conditions are below the decreed water rights listed above. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water right is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is August 14, 2025 and the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
