





# Chatfield Reservoir Reallocation Unit Purchase

Central Colorado Water Conservancy District  
Substantially Complete February 1, 2026



## Project Description

The Central Colorado Water Conservancy District (District) is located in the South Platte River basin between Denver and Fort Morgan including Beebe Draw, and the lower portions of Box Elder Creek and Lost Creek drainages. Approximately 210,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands are served by the District. The Chatfield Reservoir Reallocation Project reallocated a total of 20,600AF (Units) of storage space from the flood control pool into a multipurpose pool. The District participated in the original reallocation project and secured 4,274 Units at that time. This additional 1,000 Units will be utilized by its Groundwater Management Subdistrict (Subdistrict) to provide additional storage for augmentation water supplies within the Subdistrict. The Subdistrict will have access to the Units through an Allotment Agreement with the District.
