### SUBJECT: Shell Frontier Oil & Gas Inc., Request for Reclamation Responsibility Release Notice of Intent (NOI) # P-2009-013, Horse Draw mine Re-Entry Project Piceance Creek Basin, Rio Blanco County, Colorado

Dear Mr. Marshall:

The purpose of this letter is to request the release of reclamation responsibility for DRMS Prospecting NOI #P-2009-013. This NOI was obtained in October of 2009 to perform photographic and laser surveys and remove several large samples of nahcolitic oil shale from the existing Horse Draw mine site located on BLM land in Rio Blanco County.

Shell Frontier Oil & Gas (SFOGI) has elected not to undertake this project and no surface disturbances were created subsequent to issuance of the NOI. On August 8, 2013 the BLM issued an expiration to Right of Way Grant #COC73826 obtained by SFOGI on November 17, 2009 to allow access into the mine site. A copy of the BLM ROW expiration notice is attached.

Per the requirements of Minerals Rule 4.16.1(2), a Reclamation Report for the site is attached to this request. The report includes location and site maps, photographs showing the current condition of the site, and a statement in lieu of a description of reclamation work completed indicating that no new surface disturbances were created subsequent to issuance of the NOI. Shell's most recent bond calculation for the site totals \$64,141.00. A summary of the bond calculation is attached. Upon approval of the release, Shell requests that the estimated bond amount be credited to Travelers Casualty & Surety Company of America Statewide Prospecting Bond No. 104806644 which covers all of Shell's Prospecting NOI's on public land.

#### **STATUS OF RECLAMATION**

The Prospecting NOI was approved on October 21, 2009 for access into an existing underground mine site (Horse Draw Mine) for the purpose of conducting photographic and laser surveys and removal of several large samples of nahcolitic oil shale. A Right of Way Grant for access into the mine site was granted by the BLM on November 17, 2009 (#COC73826). Shell Frontier Oil & gas Inc. (SFOGI) has elected not to pursue development of the project and did not create any new surface disturbances at the site subsequent to NOI issuance. Weed control work was completed on portions of the site in 2012.

#### SIGNED STATEMENT

All reclamation requirements of prospecting NOI #P-2009-013 for the Horse Draw Mine Re-Entry Project have been satisfied by virtue of no new surface disturbances being created at the existing mine site subsequent to NOI issuance.

#### **Right-of-Way Expired** Case Closed

Right-of-Way COC73826 was issued to Shell Frontier Oil & Gas on November 17, 2009 for an access road and sites to Horse Draw Mine. The proposal that required the right-ofway was never implemented. There were no surface disturbance activities; therefore, case file COC73826 is closed as of the date of this decision.

This decision may be appealed to the Interior Board of Land Appeals in accordance with the regulations in Title 43 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 4.400 and the enclosed form 1842-1. The form also includes instructions for requesting a stay of the decision appealed. If an appeal is taken, the notice of appeal must be filed in this office at the above address within 30 days of the receipt of this decision. The appellant has the burden of showing that the decision is in error.
