The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received a revision for the West Elk Mine. The revision was deemed complete on October 9, 2013. The decision due date is October 19, 2013.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Mine's permit. The revision proposes to place approximately 400 linear feet of HDPE pipe into a cobble zone at the RPEE to help with drainage and stability. There is no proposed change to the mine's permit, affected or disturbed boundary with this revision. There will be no change in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of the changes proposed in this revision.
