## Public Notice

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, in accordance with Title 34, Article 33, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, hereby issues notice that on October 10, 2013, a minor revision application (MR-141) to the Bowie No. 2 Mine, Permit No. C-1996-083, operated by Bowie Resources, LLC, P.O. Box 483, Paonia, CO 81428 was considered complete for the purposes of filing. Bowie Resources, LLC is proposing to revise the disturbed area boundary to include a new cover material stockpile area and abandon plans to disturb an area east of the existing topsoil stockpile. This will result in a 0.1 acre net decrease in disturbed acreage. Bowie Resources, LLC is also proposing to designate a drying area for up to a maximum of 200,000 cubic yards of gob material to be temporarily placed un-compacted in the approved Gob Pile #3 disturbance area. The material will be stored in the drying area in the winter months, when compaction efforts are hampered by snow and freezing temperatures. When conditions allow, the material will subsequently be placed and compacted in the approved refuse disposal area in accordance with the approved refuse disposal plan. All reviews and comment periods as provided in the Act and Regulations promulgated thereunder initiate from this date of filing.
