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COMMENTS

This was a complete inspection by Leigh Simmons of Colorado Division for Reclamation, Mining and Safety, (the Division). The inspection was accompanied by Vince Masarotti of New Elk Coal Company, (NECC). The weather was fine. The weather had been mostly dry over the preceding few weeks, following a very wet monsoon season.

Consistent with the format of recent inspection reports, items needing action will be highlighted using bold text. Where possible, these items should be addressed before the next inspection. Several permitting actions are in progress, these are detailed under the heading GENERAL MINE PLAN

COMPLIANCE.

Arcadis had recently been on site to conduct vegetation sampling.

AVAILABILITY OF RECORDS - Rule 5.02.4(1):

The records had been moved to a new office in the Technical Services building. The jumble of box files had been filed into a large filing cabinet, making the files much easier to navigate. Detailed comments are at the end of this report.

HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Drainage Control 4.05.1, 4.05.2, 4.05.3; Siltation Structures 4.05.5, 4.05.6; Discharge Structures 4.05.7, 4.05.10; Diversions 4.05.4; Effluent Limits 4.05.2; Ground Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Surface Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Drainage – Acid and Toxic Materials 4.05.8; Impoundments 4.05.6, 4.05.9; Stream Buffer Zones 4.05.18:

The erosive area at the north eastern edge of the permit boundary had not yet been addressed. Mr Masarotti plans to use some bales to slow down flow. The area will continue to be monitored to determine if further repairs are necessary.

GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE:

The mine was in compliance with the permit. Technical Revision 57 is still in progress, NECC are in the process of responding to some adequacy issues.

The valves shown in photo 2 of the April 29th inspection report are associated with gas pipelines. The valves are located outside of the disturbance boundary, but are within the permit boundary. Rule 2.10.3(e) requires that any pipelines within the permit boundary be displayed on a map. NECC should verify the location of the pipeline and ensure that it is included on a map to be submitted with TR57.

NECC have carried out some vegetation sampling in order to prepare for a future bond release application. The currently approved sampling plan will likely be difficult to implement over such a small site. It is anticipated that NECC will use TR57 to revise the permit to include a more appropriate sampling plan - presumably the data that has recently been completed will be usable under the future plan.

REVEGETATION – Rule 4.15

Vegetative Cover; Timing:

As commented above, vegetation sampling has recently been completed. Arcadis were contracted to do the work. The results have not yet been analysed.
