#### **COMMENTS**

This was a partial inspection of the Bowie No. 1 Mine based on aerial photographs of the site taken by Harry Ranney and reviewed by Susan Burgmaier of DRMS. Weather conditions at the time of the flight were windy and clear; ground conditions appeared to be dry.

The East Mine, West Mine, and ROM areas have all been regraded and Phase I bond release has been granted. The loadout area of the mine remains active as a staging area for BRL drilling operations.

Backfilled and regraded slopes at the East Mine, West Mine, and ROM area all appeared to be stable with no evidence of excessive erosion, cracking, or bulging.

East Mine: The West Ridge pond held water but did not appear to be discharging. The inlet to the pond looked like it had been downcut. Pond 1 appeared to be dry; Pond 2 was holding water but did not appear to be discharging. The ROM area pond appeared to be dry.

Both refuse disposal areas at the East Mine appeared to be stable and well vegetated.
