Dear Mr. Cazier,

In response to deficiencies on our amendment application with regard to reclamation in land belonging to Avenger Productions: we are currently in discussion with the landowner about reclamation on the property. We have been informed that we are not to go onto the land for any other operations of the gravel pit, so we have not gone into the property since then.

Portions of the aforementioned land have already been reclaimed, and has seeded itself. This portion is fenced out of the active pit area and a 4' berm separates the area, as well.

We will pursue an agreement with the landowner at a later date in an effort to release the land in question and will forward any information to your office as it occurs.




